John 3:16 (NIV) For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.
Matthew 22:36-40 (NIV) "Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?" Jesus replied: "'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments."

1 John 1:9 (NIV) If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.
James 4:8 (NIV) Come near to God and he will come near to you.

Philippians 2:12 (NIV) Therefore, my dear friends, as you have always obeyed—not only in my presence, but now much more in my absence—continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling,

Living Daily in Relationship with God Means We...

Step 1 _____ **the Lord**
Proverbs 9:10 (NIV) The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom.

Fear = Honor, Respect, Put first

Step 2 _____ **in His ways**
Deuteronomy 11:16 (NIV) Be careful, or you will be enticed to turn away and worship other gods and bow down to them.

Walk = mimic Christ, following in His footsteps, talk like He would talk, live as He would live

Step 3 _____ **and** _____ **Jesus**
Deuteronomy 11:13 (NIV) So if you faithfully obey the commands I am giving you today—to love the Lord your God and to serve him with all your heart and with all your soul—

Love and serve = be the hands and feet of Jesus

Step 4 _____ **His commandments**
Deuteronomy 11:18-19 (NIV) Fix these words of mine in your hearts and minds; tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. Teach them to your children, talking about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up.

Keep = walk daily in His guidance and direction

Psalms 119:105 (NIV) Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path.
